Connolly Ranch cultivates excitement about animals, ecology, gardening, nutrition, sustainability, and nature for kids and families. We provide hands-on, interactive farmbased environmental education to over 5,000 children and adults each year through public days, preschool programs, school field trips, and seasonal camps.









OUR VISION

- Children understand and appreciate the connection between food and nature
- Napa Valley's heritage of farming and ranching is appreciated
- Kids and their families eat healthier, and are healthier
- The ranch is preserved, sustained and utilized as a community asset

For 20 years, Connolly Ranch has served Napa Valley as a unique educational center providing hands-on experiences for children of all ages. In 2014, our goals were to become more sustainable, more accessible and more equitable.

How did we do? We have made significant progress in these areas by implementing new programs, adding free days, and offering scholarships.

What's New?

- Added Walk-in Wednesdays increasing free open hours from 8 hours a year to over 40 – a 500 percent increase!
- Added Second Saturdays to provide working families a chance to enjoy classes and day camps
- Added a new Scholarship Fund to remove barriers for kids and families to participate in our programs
- Added affordable single and multi-day camps to support parents during school holidays
- Served nearly 4,000 school children on field trips at an 80 percent subsidized rate of just \$5 per child or free to those students from lowincome households
- Partnered with local nonprofits to support community initiatives like decreasing childhood obesity rates and improving access to fresh produce with donations to the Food Bank

What's on the Horizon?

- Continue to listen to our community and expand current programs and initiatives
- Create a robust volunteer and internship program with service learning projects, junior counselors, short and long-term volunteer opportunities
- Enhance programing for pre-teens and teens with an affordable afterschool program
- Enhance ranch facilities and create new educational areas: heritage poultry barn, new outdoor classrooms, restore duck pond/wetland habitat, repair Peggy Connolly's house
- Engage the public in fun and dynamic ways around issues like sustainability, naturebased education, movement, food and more – imagine a speaker on sustainability followed by a film or music in the grove.

Connolly Ranch believes there is strength in numbers. By working together with other nonprofits and local groups, Connolly Ranch can further its mission while supporting other community efforts.


- Connolly Ranch joined Live Healthy Napa County as a collaborative community partner. We participated in the obesity prevention coalition group to help create an action plan focused on decreasing obesity rates in Napa, especially in children.
- Connolly Ranch connected the Harvest Festival with local Food Day to educate people on where our food comes from and show them how fun eating fresh healthy fruits and vegetables can be. Efforts included participating in Napa's downtown health fair at the Farmers' Market and hosting nonprofit booths at Connolly Ranch in the afternoon.
- Connolly Ranch supported Napa Valley CanDo's efforts to provide fresh fruit and vegetables to the Napa Food Bank by dedicating a garden plot to the project. Throughout the growing seasons, children visiting Connolly Ranch participated in educational garden projects to plant and harvest produce for families in need.
- We are proud to have partnered with the Napa Solano
 Audubon Society to host the Inaugural Christmas Bird Count
 for Kids. This citizens science event brings together all the
 elements of bird watching to introduce the next generation
 of stewards to the importance of birds in the ecosystem, the
 tradition of annual bird counts and the fun of getting families
 outside to exercise and engage with the natural world.



Scholarship Fund

With support from our donors, Connolly Ranch provides full and partial scholarships based on financial need for all its programs.

Legacy Fund

Members of the Legacy Fund are sustaining donors committed to ensuring that Connolly Ranch has a reliable source of funding by making an annual gift.

\$25 - Gives a scholarship for a parent and child program to a family in need

\$50 - Provides a day camp for a child in need

\$100 - Pays for teaching supplies for a farm-to-table field trip for 60 kids

\$250 - Supports free afternoon on Walk-in Wednesday

\$500 - Gives an interactive, hands-on educational field trip for 30 kids from low-income families

\$1,000 - Feeds our farm animals for an entire month

\$2,500 - Helps cover the day-to-day costs of maintaining an educational farm

\$5,000 Completes construction of an outdoor classroom!
