
Burkina Faso Coverage Report – SMC Cycle 3 2017

Preimilary report

Notes: Survey took place between 12th Ocotber and 19th October 2017, across 7 Districts (Figure 1). A total of 1,419 households were visited and 91.1% (1293/1419) agreed to participate in the survey, the reasons for non-response (126/1419) were; the inability to find someone to speak with (n=38); no children aged between 3 months and 7 years (n=80); and interviewers unable to access compound (n=8).

Overall coverage was 94.5%, however this hides some of the regional variablility (Table 1). The most common reason given for not receiving SMC was the child was living away or the child was unwell. (Table 2). Coverage of SMC amongst older children (6 or more years old) and was 13.5% (Table 6).
