## REPORT ON PROJECT IMPLEMETATION RESULTS FOR MDA 2 - 2016

Project: Vietnam Integrated Deworming, Sanitation and Hygiene Program

Funded by: East Meets West Foundation

Timeline: July to December 2016

Project sites: Hoa Binh, Phu Tho, Thanh Hoa, and Nghe An

Agency: National Institute of Malariology Parasitology and Entomology

### I. IMPLEMENTATION RESULTS

## 1. Training

- NIMPE incorporated with VIHEMA AND EMW organize repeated training for provincial officers on regular deworming before MDA2.
  - The delegations attending training class are the heads, lecturers, officers from NIMPE, officers from VIHEMA and EMW representatives.
  - Trainees include: the heads and personnel from the Provincial Centre of Malariology, Parasitology and Entomology, Provincial Preventive Medicine Centre in 4 provinces; the heads and officers in charge of school health from Department of Education and Training of 4 provinces.

Among 24 trainees from 4 provinces, there are 12 males, 12 females, 5 director/vice directors from PIMPE/PPMC, 1 DoET director and 18 officers from health and education sectors.

All trainees follow regulations set by organization board. Pre-test results show that 15/24 trainees passed. During the training session, officers share their difficulties and experience while implementing MDA at their province, which contribute to the success of the training.

At the end of session, all of them pass the post-tests that proves trainees really gain knowledge from training program, so they are now able to apply them into MDA2 at their province.

## 2. Mass Drug Administration

## 2.1 Delivering tablets

NIMPE has distributed tablets for primary students over 4 provinces based on the estimated student number submitted by each province. The total quantity of mebendazole 500mg delivered to 4 provinces for MDA2 is 716.630 tablets. All provinces arrange to receive tablets at NIMPE's warehouse.

Coverage rate over 4 provinces is quite high (>98%), there is no adverse events founded after taking tablet. Posters and communication materials distributed to Thanh Hoa and Nghe An provinces use fund from Deworming program by Ministry of Health in 2016.

# 2.3 Monitoring

NIMPE conducted monitoring on deworming day at 2 provinces Hoa Binh and Phu Tho. Findings are presented below:

- Authorities at all levels fully support implementation of the program
- Training sessions are organized as planned
- Well cooperation between education and health sector at all levels
- All schools hang banners from donor
- Permission forms are sent out to parents before deworming day and got high percentage of agreement
- Deworming activities are implemented smoothly under a standard procedure by well-trained officers.

- Careful preparation in response to adverse events. Health workers are available 24/24 on deworming day at commune health centers and clinics.
- Coverage rate at monitored schools is quite high, >98%.
- Arrange for non-enrolled 6-11 years old children to take tablet at commune health centers
- There is no adverse events found at monitored schools

#### II. Disbursement

- Disbursement result at provincial level will be reported directly to VIHEMA and EMW.
- NIMPE has finished disbursement nearly 95% for all activities: training, monitoring on deworming at 2 provinces. At present, only payment for administration fee of project management board is pending.

#### III. Recommendations

- Implementation plan should be planned earlier in the next MDAs.
- It's not necessary to organize every repeated training session before each MDA, instead, the fund for repeated trainings could be paid for officers at commune level who involve in MDA implementation.
- The printing budget for banner and other receipts is limited which causes difficulties.
- Provinces should be provided fund for designing and printing communication materials relating to prevention of worm-infection.
- Administration procedures should be less time-consuming (contract signing and contract liquidation).
