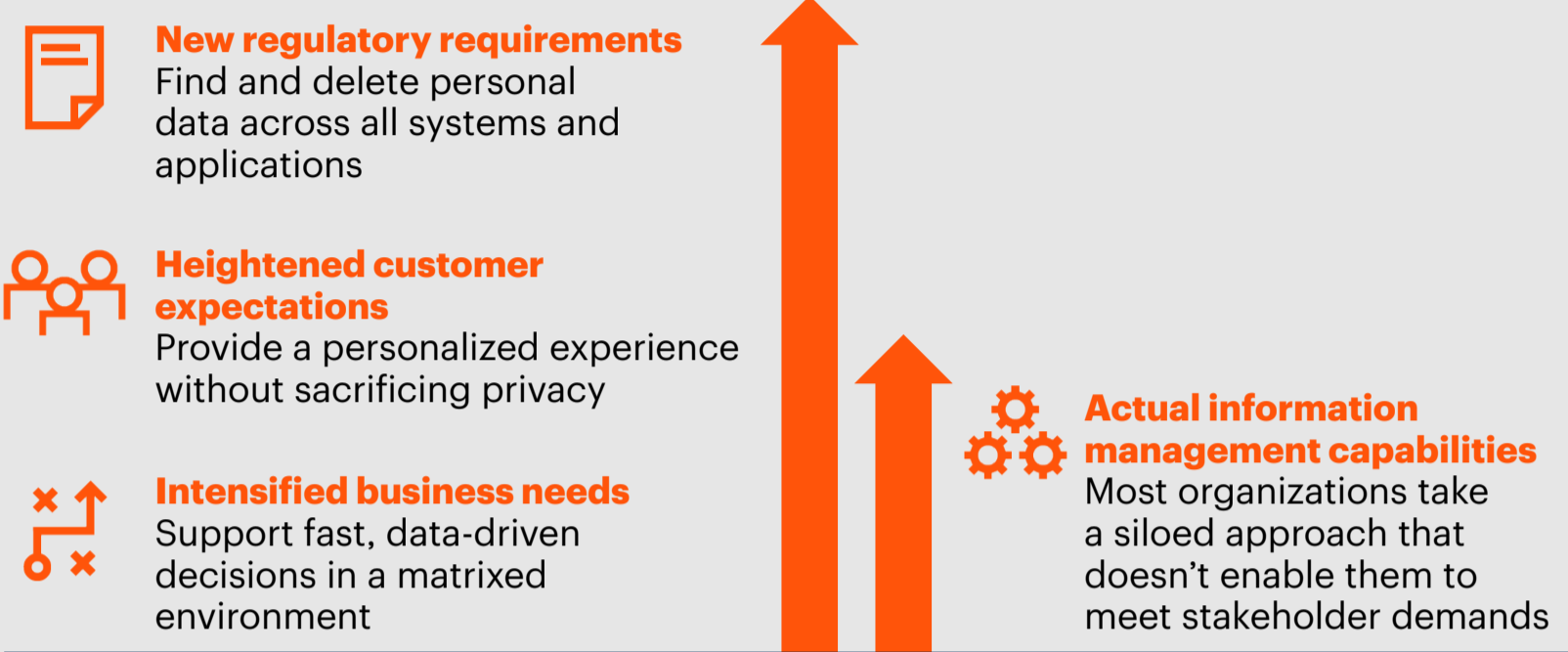

Legal executives face many obstacles to success

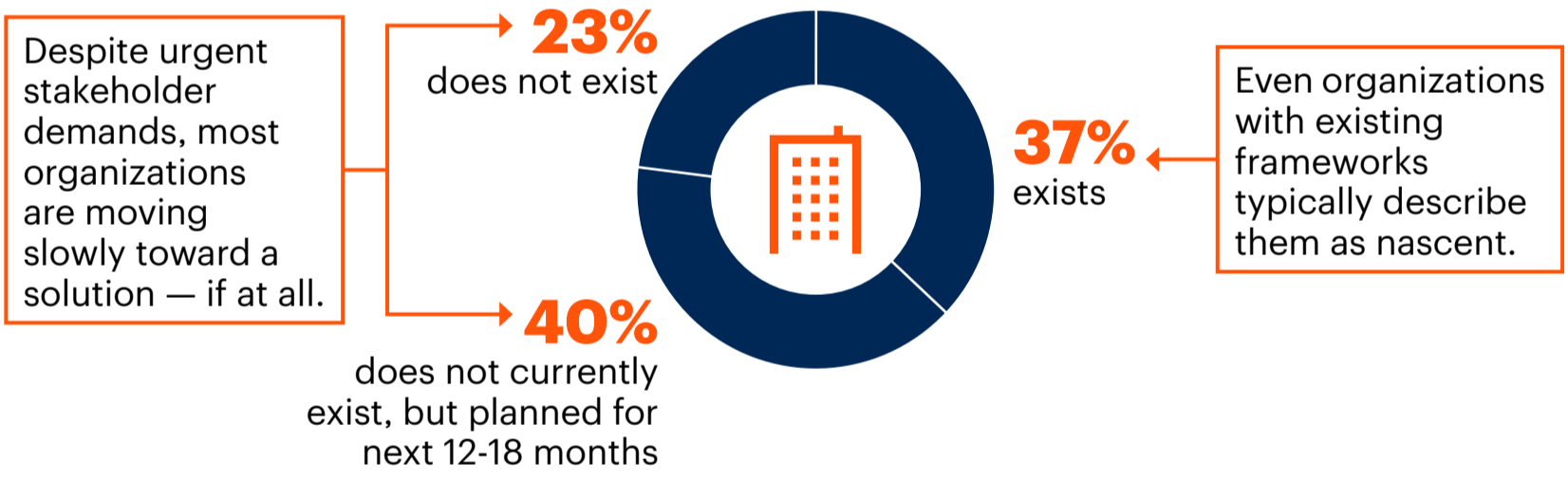
Here are the top 3 cited challenges to information governance implementation:
