Raon Parcaidh / Car Park – Pick up/Drop off Issue

We have recently had reports of near misses in the car park where cars are driving carelessly, too fast and often within the coned off area or drop off only and bus parking areas. We politely ask all parents and guardians to please slow down and drive with extra care and vigilance so as to keep all children as safe as possible. We appreciate the car park is small and this can cause frustration, but with weather warnings of snow and ice imminent, we all need to be even more careful to keep everyone safe.

BSGI Car Park is facing congestion problems on a daily basis and we are looking for support from all parents/carers to help us tackle the issue. Where possible, we encourage our pupils to travel to school in the healthiest ways by promoting walking, cycling and scooting to school. This is celebrated at BSGI as part of our GO FOR IT rewards shared in class.

For children who are being dropped off by parents we would like your family to join us and help to promote the following activities –

- Usage of Long Stay Parking Bays: Priority for Highland Council staff. Car park bays are for the use of persons with a Parking Permit and Nursery Parents/Carers only.
- Our family will only drive to school if necessary and park at Rollerbowl and walk/bike/scoot from there. We will go by foot, bike, scooter when possible.
- Our family will stay within the speed limits of the school car park 5mph zone and not park on pavements, zigzag lines or on the turning circle causing an obstruction.
- Our family will always park sensibly and <u>never in the Drop-off Zone.</u> This is a constantly moving space and cars should be able to queue to drop children. If you exit your vehicle and use our car park, please find a parking bay. Unfortunately if there are no bays, parking at Rollerbowl and walking is the only option.
- Our family will not park in the Bus Zone and cause access problems. This area is strictly for buses.
- Our family will not leave engines running within school grounds.
