1 The Company has been incorporated on June 24, 2002 as a private company limited by guarantee and not having a share capital and has been granted a license under Section 25 of the Companies Act, 1956 by Government of India, vide its letter No. 59/(25/N)/3/02/3720 dated May 30, 2002. The Company is registered underSection 6(1)(a) of FCR Act on May 22, 2006 and Registration No is 083781058. The Company is registered under Section 12AA of the Income Tax Act, 1961 vide Letter No. DIT(E)/12A/36899/2002-2003 dated December 18, 2002. The Company is registered under Section 80 G of the Income Tax Act, 1961 vide letter No. DIT (E) / MC/80G/1895/2009-10 dated July 20, 2009 and the registration is valid up to March 31, 2012.

2 Significant Accounting Policies

(a) Basis of Accounting

The Financial Statements are prepared to comply in all material aspects with all the applicable accounting principles in India, the applicable accounting standards notified u/s 211(3C) of the Companies Act, 1956 and the relevant provisions of the Companies Act, 1956.

The Company is a Small and Medium Sized Company (SMC) as defined in the General Instructions in respect of Accounting Standards notified under the Companies Act, 1956. Accordingly, the Company has complied with the Accounting Standards as applicable to a SMC.

(b) Fixed Assets and Depreciation

Fixed assets are stated at cost of acquisition, including any attributable cost for bringing the assets to its working condition for its intended use, less accumulated depreciation.

Depreciation is calculated on written down value method at the rate of 60% on computers on a prorata basis from the month of purchase.

Fixed assets whose cost is Rs. 5,000 or less, are fully depreciated in the year of purchase.

(c) Donations

Donations received in foreign currency are accounted on the date of realisation. Donations received in local currency are accounted on the date of receipt.
