

2006 showed that the median urinary iodine level of whole country was 82.5 µg/L. The median values were 92.5, 61.1, 84.4 and 101 µg/L in the North, the Northeast, the Central and the South regions, respectively.

- Random checks of household coverage by adequately iodized salt in communities and community shops increased from 54.4% in 2005 to 63.8% in 2006. In 2007 the coverage was 81.5%

Median UICs are now in the adequate range in schoolchildren, women of reproductive age and, in many provinces, in pregnant women.
