Late Arrivals and Early Dismissal

For safety and accountability purposes the district requires students to be signed in and out of school in the Power Schools Student Data Management System. Students who arrive late to school or must leave before the school day ends, will be signed in/out in the front office.

Parents, if you pull up to the main entrance someone will come out and help you sign your student in or out. Students who arrive late will receive tardy slips. Students who leave before 2:20 must be signed out of school. We will make every effort to expedite this process as we know that you are very busy!
