# Safety starts at home

We want to make sure that the people at school are safe and healthy before they arrive at school. For anyone planning to attend school – staff or students—please consider the following guidelines:

### Please stay home if:

- you are not feeling well, or others at your home are not well;
- you have a temp 100.4° F or greater;
- If you have signs of COVID-19 which includes fever, chills, body aches, headache, sore throat, change in smell or taste, cough, shortness of breath, or difficulty breathing. Please refer to the Symptom Screening Checklist (StongSchoolsNC: Public Health Toolkit)

# Arrival 7:25 AM-7:55 AM

## Car Riders

### New drop off procedures

- Five numbered cones will be set up along the fence to expedite drop off.
- Cars will be directed by "The Caller" to pull up to a designated cone.
- Once parked, car riders will be greeted by staff
- Staff will take the temperatures of every passenger and conduct the WS/FCS Entry Questionnaire for Students
  - A student with a temperature.of 100.4° F or higher will not be permitted to exit their vehicle.
  - The COVID Coordinator will keep a log of students whose temperature is above 100.4°F
  - For students with mobility equipment: Parents will park their car, exit the vehicle and place the student securely in the wheelchair.

Staff will escort students to class.

## Late Arrival

- Students are considered late for school if they arrive after 7:55 AM
  - o Parents will pull up to the entrance.
  - A staff member will come out to screen, sign the student in and issue a tardy slip.

# Dismissal/End of the Day 2:25-3:00

#### Bus riders 2:25-2:40

### Forms to Safely Ride the bus:

- Bus riders will be dismissed one classroom/bus at a time, in order to avoid congested hallways
  - o This will slow down the process but keep our students and staff safe
- Staff will wear appropriate PPE
- Staff will escort students from class to the bus.
- Staff will fasten students securely in harnesses or other safety equipment
- Staff will wash their hands or use hand sanitizer after escorting each student to the bus
- Maintain social distancing for students and staff during dismissal, as much as possible

#### Car riders 2:40-3:00

- Car riders will be picked up at the main entrance via the car rider line. (see the duty roster)
- Cars will be directed to numbered cones using the same procedure as morning drop off.
- Staff will escort students to meet their ride using the exterior doors or following our one way in one way out traffic pattern
- Parents will be greeted outside by school staff (see the duty roster) and asked to remain in their car
- Staff will escort students from class to their cars, wearing appropriate PPE (masks, gloves, and shields).
- Staff will wash their hands or use hand sanitizer after escorting each student.

- School doors will be open to help with air flow and limit the need to touch the doors
- After students have been safely dismissed, staff will return to their classrooms to help wipe down, disinfect their classroom, and clean student items.
- Medical professionals recommend that staff change their clothes before returning home and interacting with others. Clothes should be washed each night.

### Early Dismissal

- o Parents will pull up to the entrance.
- o Come to the door to screen, sign out the student with office staff.
- Classroom Assistant will be called to bring the student to the front.
- Temperature checked and documented by office staff prior to the student leaving the building.

## Meals

#### **Students**

- All student meals will be eaten in the classroom.
- The cafeteria staff will prepare the meals per Child Nutrition and medical guidelines.
- Students will be safely distanced from each other.
- Teacher Assistants will pick up lunches and deliver them to the classroom.
- Students may not share meals.
- Staff will wash their hands before and after helping each child.
- Eating Utensils
  - Students who require specialized eating utensils must have two sets.
  - o Utensils will be collected and sanitized in the dishwasher each day.
  - Utensils will be stored in a closed, sanitary container in the classroom.
- Staff assisting with lunch will wear appropriate PPE including masks, shields and gloves.
- Staff will follow normal procedures for tube feeding with the addition of PPE.
- Mid-day temperature checks and logs collected by the COVID Coordinator

## Personal Care Needs

- Procedures for assisting with personal hygiene will continue with additional safety precautions to protect students
- Staff will don PPE when assisting with personal care needs
