- Racing Services: For those affiliates who organise racing we provide a plethora of services to assist them in attracting more racing participants and volunteers, retaining them in the sport for longer and making racing as enjoyable as possible;
- Training & Development: We supply the training framework, standards, syllabus and development opportunities to deliver safe and successful boating for members to attract, train and retain new members and volunteers:

PROMOTING AND PROTECTING 1. REWARDING BRITISH BOATING:

As our sports National Governing Body we work hard to protect your members recreational boating interests by:

> Providing a robust, articulate and intelligent voice to represent recreational boating on all relevant aspects of legislation and policy. This ensures that legislators, regulators and other authorities understand and take account of recreational boating activity;

SAFE, SUCCESSFUL AND

Seeking to influence in order to remain a selfregulated activity where our preferred approach of taking personal responsibility and 'education not legislation' prevails;

Resisting legislation or red tape that we believe to be disproportionate, ineffective or unenforceable, or will place an unnecessary burden on our affiliates and the many volunteers upon which the sport relies;

Providing an RYA Safety Management System of incident reporting, maintaining a comprehensive log of any incidents: Identifying trends and lessons learned and sharing information accordingly through relevant RYA channels and RYA Safety Advisory Notices;

Acting as the UK National Governing Body with regard to applying for, and dispersing, public funding to develop participation and performance in the sport. Advising and supporting affiliates with their applications to funding bodies and Sports Councils.

4. RACING SERVICES

Not all of our affiliates are interested in racing, but many are, therefore providing the following services is a significant part of our affiliation package:

Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and rules disputes processes: The RYA is responsible for the administration of the RRS in the UK. We provide education and training for participants and volunteers to help organisations understand and apply the RRS. In the event of a query or rules dispute that can't be resolved internally you can seek advice or use the appeals process whereby RYA experts will handle the situation accordingly.

Technical and measurement services: We support affiliates in the training of technical volunteers and equipment inspectors to RYA and ISAF standards. in order to ensure a consistent application of class rules within your organisations delivery of racing activities.

Handicapping: The RYA coordinates the Portsmouth Yardstick (PY) and National Handicap for Cruisers (NHC) systems in order to allow the benchmarking of different classes and designs to enable sailors to race against each other, as fairly as possible.

Coaching: The RYA provides the coach education and development framework, and offers subsidised training and development programmes to upskill coaches to support affiliates in the development of sailors.

Support service: The RYA Racing Department will help you find appropriately qualified and experienced race officials and coaches to support you in the delivery of a specific event or activity.





5. TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT

We encourage and support affiliates to provide RYA training and progress to become an RYA Recognised Training Centre. This offers access to a wide range of internationally recognised training and development programmes to assist in the development and retention of members, staff and volunteers.

Training and qualification schemes and ongoing development opportunities for club welfare officers, instructors, level 2 racing coaches and race officials: Regular courses and

development opportunities are provided both regionally and nationally. These help you increase the number of trained personnel within your organisation and develop their competence and confidence, enhancing the quality of experience for your members;

International Certificate of Competence (ICC)
Assessment: Clubs can become an assessment centre for the ICC in order to help members obtain an ICC (which is free for RYA members).
