
There are tons of free/paid WordPress themes/plugins.

Having to choose between a free and premium theme/plugin



The answer depends on your preferences and site needs. There are cool free themes that feel like a premium theme, from being regularly updated to having general support.

If you just want a personal blog, and you don't plan on customizing your website and then a free theme will be good.

But if you are a business owner, or you want to make serious money with your website then a premium theme is the way to go.

3. SIMPLICITY


A website with a simple but appealing design can attract millions of visitors and give more business opportunities.

Right now, the percentage of mobile users online is greater than the web. You want to make sure you cater for mobile users.


Most website builders create responsive WordPress sites for a number of reasons to perform well in search engine rankings and generate more business opportunities.
