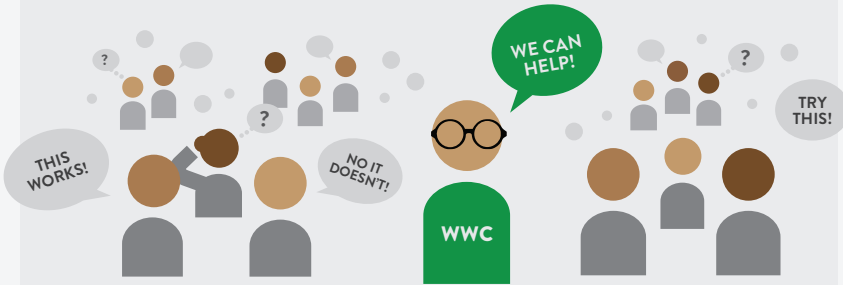


WHAT IS THE WWC?
