IHSS is a program that keeps aged, blind and disabled Californians safely in their own homes and prevents out-of-home placement in nursing and other long-term care facilities. IHSS providers are responsible to shop for groceries and other items for their recipients, as well as take care of their personal care needs.

IHSS providers have been deemed essential by the Governor and as such, are not subject to the shelter-in-place orders if they are performing duties associated with the IHSS program and supporting their recipient.
