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
Executive Summary

KIPP Academy is located in the Bronx and provides an extended day/extended year education for middle school Hispanic and African-American students. In the 2006 school year:

- > Three-fifths or more of the students in all grades demonstrated grade appropriate reading skills.
- ➤ A higher percentage of seventh graders than students in other grades read at the appropriate level.
- ➤ At least 87% of the students in each class demonstrated grade appropriate math skills.

Description of Students


There were 265 students enrolled in KIPP Academy in the 2006 school year. Nearly all were Hispanic (55%) or African-American (43%). There were more girls (58%) than boys. The majority (94%) received a free or reduced price lunch.





Attendance

Average Daily Attendance



The average daily attendance for each of the past six years has been high (96% to 98%). During the 2006 school year, the average student missed about 5 days of school during the year.

Achievement of Students

During the 2006 school year, three-fifths or more of the students in each cohort achieved reading scores that placed them in levels 3 or 4, indicating that they met or exceeded all of the standards expected for students at their grade levels. The reading levels of the Class of 2007 and the Class of 2008 are about the same as last year. The Class of 2006 declined.

Math scores are available for fifth through eighth grade students attending the KIPP Academy in 2006. 87% or more of the students in these grades scored in levels 3 or 4, indicating they met all the standards for their grade levels. In 2006, a higher percentage of students in the Class of 2008 were proficient in math than in 2005.
