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| WINEMAKER'S<br>INSIGHT   | Grown from the four best blocks of our Hirondelle<br>Estate Vineyard, this wine opens with deep blackcurrant<br>aromas with a hint of clove. Silky tannins and rich<br>flavors of blueberry, mocha, and spice are followed by a<br>long, velvety finish.   |
| HARVEST  | Following heavy rainfall in the winter season, the 2017<br>harvest began with early vine growth and mild weather<br>patterns. In early September, heat spikes hit the valley<br>and set record temperatures. To preserve hydration,<br>the vines were heavily irrigated until the temperatures<br>cooled in mid-September.   |
| HISTORY  | Clos du Val, French for "small vineyard estate of a small<br>valley," was founded in 1972 in the renowned Stags Leap<br>District. The winery was first recognized for its Cabernet<br>Sauvignon at the famed Judgment of Paris in 1976,<br>establishing its place as one of Napa Valley's most iconic<br>winery estates. Still family-owned today, Clos du Val<br>farms two estate vineyards in the Stags Leap District and<br>Yountville appellations and continues to craft wines of<br>balance and complexity, showcasing the fruit from the<br>outstanding terroir on which our estate lies. |

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
