- Mostly funded by membership fees and donations (from IOGT-NTO Movement in Sweden)  
- 3.3 FTEs  
- Primarily advocate to multilateral organizations for increased attention to alcohol control  
- Runs programs, conferences, capacity building workshops, produces materials and provides support to national NGOs in their advocacy and prevention work
