A Message from Dr. Tufts:

Hello Families,

At Howell Mountain ESD, your child's safety is our primary responsibility. We will be providing weekly COVID-19 tests so that we will be able to verify that your child's classroom is a safe place for your child to be. Weekly tests will be on Wednesdays after 1:00. At this time, both students and staff will have the opportunity to test for COVID-19. Families are also welcomed to join our testing site. If you are interested, please let our front office know and we will put your names on the list. We will need to have a waiver signed and returned so that you and your child will be able to participate. In addition to the weekly tests, we have ordered Binax, antigen tests-which are rapid tests. The rapid tests may be used to rule out Covid-19. which may help your child to return to school before the 10 days of quarantine, should your child develop any signs of illness. The signed waiver will also be used to allow your child to be tested at school.

Thank you for understanding and thank you for supporting our mission to keep our students healthy and in school.
