The Safeguarding Champion of Sport Resolutions (UK) will be elected from the Board at each Annual General Meeting. They can be a Representative or Independent Non-Executive Director.

Term: one year, appointed at each Annual General Meeting

Responsibilities

To ensure that safeguarding is included as an agenda item at Board meetings whenever appropriate.

To ensure that the Board takes safeguarding issues into consideration when making decisions.

To present to the Board, on an annual basis, statistical and qualitative equality information.

To work with the Lead Safeguarding Officer and/or Deputy Safeguarding Officer on the 'Safeguarding Standard for Sport'.

To contribute to and to approve the Safeguarding Action Plan.

To be available as a member of the pool of Directors for the Complaints/Grievance, Disciplinary and Appeals processes.

To help ensure that all employees receive up to date training on Safeguarding.

This is a voluntary position which is not remunerated other than for the reimbursement of travel expenses to attend board meetings and events.
