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California Ambulance Strike Team Program ASTL Qualification Renewal Process

Renewal requirements and process (interim process)

- Renewal is required every 5 years
- For renewal of the ASTL Qualification:
 - A completed PTB with 1-2 qualifying Evaluation Records with supporting documentation (214s) and LEMSA approval/signature.
 - The Evaluation Record events should have occurred within the timeframe of the current ASTL certification or within the last 5 years.
 - Minimum of 1 real world event or 2 training events, or combination of training and real world events.
 - The “qualifying event” to be used for Evaluation Record is determined by the LEMSA, the event should provide adequate experience and opportunity to practice and demonstrate the tasks outlined in the PTB.
 - Write “RENEWAL” on the top of the first page of the PTB.
 - Include a copy of current ASTL card OR write in the ASTL number, issue and expiration date on the front of the PTB.
 - Letter of recommendation from employer, dated same as renewal packet.
 - Submission is still the same process – Scan all files into one PDF > Provider > LEMSA > EMSA.

**This is the interim process for ASTL renewal, EMSA will develop a more streamlined renewal process for ASTL Qualification in the future.*
