2. THE AVAILABILITY OF SIMILAR SERVICES IN THE GEOGRAPHIC AREA OF THIS ORGANIZATION.

3. CURRENT COMPENSATION SURVEYS COMPILED BY INDEPENDENT FIRMS.

4. ACTUAL WRITTEN OFFERS FROM SIMILAR INSTITUTIONS COMPETING FOR THE SERVICES OF THE PERSON WHO IS THE SUBJECT OF THE COMPENSATION ARRANGEMENT.

3. THE COMPARABILITY DATA OBTAINED AND RELIED UPON AND HOW THE DATA WAS OBTAINED.

4. IF THE BOARD OR COMPENSATION COMMITTEE DETERMINES THAT REASONABLE COMPENSATION FOR A SPECIFIC POSITION IN THIS ORGANIZATION OR FOR PROVIDING SERVICES UNDER ANY OTHER COMPENSATION ARRANGEMENT WITH THIS ORGANIZATION IS HIGHER OR LOWER THAN THE RANGE OF COMPARABILITY DATA OBTAINED, THE BOARD OR COMMITTEE SHALL RECORD IN THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING THE BASIS FOR ITS DETERMINATION.

6. ANY ACTIONS TAKEN WITH RESPECT TO DETERMINING IF A BOARD OR COMMITTEE MEMBER HAD A CONFLICT OF INTEREST WITH RESPECT TO THE COMPENSATION ARRANGEMENT, AND IF SO, ACTIONS TAKEN TO MAKE SURE THE MEMBER WITH THE
